Workshop 1 Survey – some results (1)

- Extreme weather was highlighted by participants as the most important source of disruption
 - Several noted that this interacts with airport capacity limits airports close to capacity cannot recover as easily
 - Climate change and more airports operating close to capacity were mentioned as future problems
- Current system bottlenecks and process deficiencies in crisis management mentioned included:
 - Lack of or poor information sharing and collaboration
 - Institutional barriers (e.g. a reluctance to use the latest technologies)
 - Existing infrastructure
 - Lack of passenger data collection (e.g. knowing passenger location)





Workshop 1 Survey – some results (2)

- What are the challenges to increasing multimodality in crisis management?
 - Most respondents (11/13 answering this question) agreed increasing use of other modes was worthwhile
 - Challenges highlighted included passenger acceptability, getting information to passengers, co-ordinating with ground transport and acceptability to transport providers
- What ideas, concepts and technologies should we investigate?
 - Many concepts discussed, including TAMs, real-time data collection and distribution, ITS, passenger data provision and/or tracking via mobile phones
- What KPIs are missing to measure the passenger experience?
 - Door-to-door journey metrics, passenger costs and weighting delays by perception were discussed
